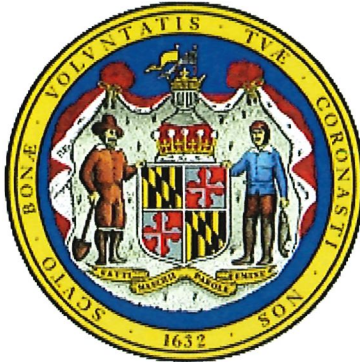




# CONFLUENCE OF STATES



Addendum  
May 26, 2022  
Little Rock, Arkansas

Whereas the Confluence Accords were signed by representatives from the outdoor recreation sector from Colorado, Montana, North Carolina, Oregon, Utah, Vermont, Washington and Wyoming on July 25, 2018, in Denver Colorado, creating the Confluence of States; and

Whereas Maine, Michigan, Nevada, New Mexico, and Virginia joined the Confluence of States October 24, 2019 by signing the Confluence Accords in Saint George, Utah; and

Whereas the Confluence of States continues to grow and benefit from enhanced participation in outdoor recreation and engagement from states that wish to advance shared principles of Conservation and Stewardship, Education and Workforce Training, Economic Development, and Public Health and Wellness outlined in the Confluence Accords;

Therefore, on this day, May 26, 2022, the undersigned representatives for the outdoor recreation sector do hereby adopt the Confluence Accords and join the Confluence of States in upholding these principles:
