BRIEF HISTORY

New Hampshire's Office of Outdoor Recreation Industry Development began as bipartisan legislation in the state senate that was eventually incorporated in the state's biennial budget. The office was established to support New Hampshire's diverse outdoor economy and connect the state's world class outdoor assets to broad economic development strategies such as workforce and business recruitment. In 2019, the Office of Outdoor Recreation Industry Development was codified creating a permanent support for the outdoor industry in New Hampshire.
